Old Business

Youth Leadership Retreat – April 6-8, Embassy Suites, DTC. Cost will be \$100 per explorer and if bringing coed explorers then your post must bring one male and one female advisor who attend for free, and advisor must assist with the retreat. Any other advisors must pay the \$100 for the weekend.

Mock Disaster – Saturday, April 28th, 2018, National Western Complex, Denver.

- FEE; Fee at \$15 to \$20 per post, regardless of the numbers attending. Our biggest cost would be pizza and drinks. Volunteers from non-emergency services posts or from scouting will attend at no costs.
- REGISTRATION; The Denver Council has offered to allow us to use their on-line registration for this event. However they do have to charge us, I believe 10% of the fees. If James is present perhaps he can explain how this could work. This was discussed and LEEPAAC will handle the registration for the event.
- RADIOS; Can an agency provide us with radios, like we use at conference, for the mock? We would need the agency to reserve a tac channel for the time of the event. Arapahoe County SO will provide the radios.
- SECURITY; I need a post to provide a few advisors to be the on-site security. Weapons will be restricted inside the event perimeter so it will be necessary to have security on scene. Denver PD?
- COMMAND POST; Can any agency provide a command post for the event?
- FOOD; Danielle Huskey is waiting for her command to approve her to handle the food for this event. Hopefully that will happen. See if she needs some assistance. James Dockter thinks he can find a supplier for the pizza. James Dockter will be looking into the pizza.
- ADVISORS; Need advisors to assist with the program, some in the command post to help direct the event, some to be in the play area to monitor for safety and to provide direction to the kids if they get stuck. Advisors will be airing information, some accurate some not so much, from the command post. It is not a real event without a lot of confusion. We will create the confusion.
