**New Business**

LEEPAAC Scholarships – Deadline is April 27<sup>th</sup>, will decide at the May LEEPAAC meeting. Requirements are as follows: Essay on “What can law enforcement and the community do to foster a positive relationship, and what does your department do to create that positive relationship?” 500 word maximum, they need a letter from their advisor, a letter from their teacher, school transcripts, and if not enrolled in a school of higher education yet, a copy of an acceptance letter to a college or university.

Need nominations for the Tom Wilkes Advisor of the Year award, deadline is April 27<sup>th</sup>, will decide at the May LEEPAAC meeting

ELT – Deadline is April 27<sup>th</sup>, need a letter of support from an advisor, and a 500 word essay on what are desirable skills that any true leader should have. Will decide at the May LEEPAAC meeting.
